The Marin County Department of Human Resources and the Department of Public Works are conducting a recruitment for the position of Chief of Construction – Roads. As a member of the Roads Division, this position is a management-level supervisory classification responsible for Roads projects and improvements within County-maintained rights-of-way, whether performed by the County or by others under encroachment permits. The Chief of Construction – Roads may be responsible for supervision of County Engineering and/or Roads personnel during design and construction phases of work, and monitoring or directing of contracted or permitted construction projects, with emphasis on enforcement of pertinent laws and regulations applicable to anyone performing work within said rights-of-way. The Chief of Construction – Roads works closely with Land Development Division in the development of encroachment permit conditions.

Our highly qualified candidate is technically knowledgeable and experienced in the principles and practices of road maintenance and construction, drainage, California Streets and Highways Code, Marin County Code where it applies to County-maintained rights-of-way, and road construction means and methods. Additionally, they should possess knowledge of the various geography and unique issues related to various areas of the County. This person is an effective communicator, both orally and in writing, and able to represent the County at meetings, giving presentations to various stakeholders, including community groups and the general public, regulatory and other governmental agencies. The highly qualified candidate is customer-focused and has strong interpersonal skills in working with staff, other County departments, engineers, contractors, other agencies and the public. This candidate also has experience in project management directing personnel and technical staff on a day-to-day basis. They can effectively analyze and evaluate alternatives, make sound recommendations based on conditions both known and unforeseen in the field, and prepare technical reports. The candidate also successfully carries out projects and assignments independently yet thrives in a team environment that encourages cooperation, communication and mutual sharing of risk, responsibility and reward, with additional focus on enhancing the knowledge and capabilities of less experienced employees and design and/or inspection team members of other agencies designing and building projects in County rights-of-way.
