The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Sacramento/Shasta-Butte Area Electrician Apprenticeship and Pre-Apprenticeship Programs are taking applications.

An Apprenticeship is a five-year “*learn while you earn*” opportunity to become an Inside Wireman (Electrician). It provides free, college-accredited classroom training combined with paid on-the-job training in the electrical trade. Completing the apprenticeship results in promotion to journey-level electrician at the prevailing hourly wage which is currently \$40.06 per hour plus benefits.

The Pre-Apprenticeship is a three-year “*learn while you earn*” opportunity to become a senior level construction wireman. It provides free classroom training combined with paid on-the-job training in the electrical trade. Completing the pre-apprenticeship results in promotion to senior-level construction wireman with a current wage rate of \$19.17 per hour plus benefits.

Application information is taken in person at the Training Center on Wednesdays between the hours of 8 – 11 a.m. and 1 – 4 p.m. Applications are also available online at www.340iatc.org and item #3 and either #4 or #5 or #6 as listed below can be mailed to the address shown.

To qualify to apply for Apprenticeship:

1. Complete an application form in person or online,
2. Be at least 18 years old or older,
3. Provide two (2) forms of identification: A valid driver’s license and one (1) of the following: Social Security card, U.S. birth certificate, or current U.S. Passport.
4. Provide a copy of high school diploma, college degree, or GED certificate
5. Provide an official transcript showing:
 - a. completion of 1 year of high school algebra or 1 semester of college algebra with a grade of C or better, or
 - b. GED passing scores,
6. Applicants who can document that they have worked a minimum of four-thousand (4000) hours specifically in the electrical construction industry will qualify for an oral interview by meeting the requirements of items (1), (2), and (3) only.
7. Applicants who can document military experience within the past 5 years via a DD-214 will qualify by meeting the requirements of items (1), (2), and (3) only.

To qualify to apply for Pre-Apprenticeship:

1. Complete an application form in person or online,
2. Be at least 18 year,
3. Provide two (2) forms of identification: A valid driver’s license and one (1) of the following: Social Security card, U. S. birth certificate, or current U.S. Passport.

These training programs are sponsored by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) and the National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA) and are equal opportunity programs.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices does not discriminate based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years old or older—except the applicant must meet the minimum age requirement. Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.
