Apprentice)

In a trainee capacity, the Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Mechanic Apprentice performs a variety of progressively more complex duties involved in the air conditioning/refrigeration mechanic trade which include performing a full range of service, maintenance and repair work on complex air conditioning and refrigeration systems and associated HVAC systems and equipment.

As this is a four-year training classification and not intended for the employment of journey-level Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Mechanics, incumbents generally are not appointed to this classification for more than four years. Upon certification of journey-level capability, incumbents will become eligible for appointment or transition to the Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Mechanic classification; however, placement into the Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Mechanic classification is not guaranteed.
